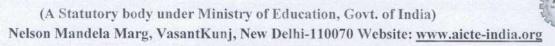

- i. The balance amount of the grant will be reimbursed to the university/institution only on submission of the above documents. V. General instructions

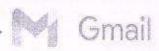

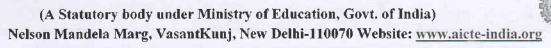

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time, no further extension will be granted in any case and institute has to refund the entire amount to AICTE.

d. As AICTE needs adequate time for depositing the Demand Draft in the bank, the same be immediately dispatched to avoid any lapse of the validity period.

IV. Submission of documents by college/institution after completion of Project/Subsequent years.

The following mandatory relevant documents are required to be submitted by the college/institution within one month of the completion of the project: -

- a. Feedback form in the prescribed proforma.
- b. The Annual Progress Report (APR) in the prescribed format along with the original Statement of actual Expenditure in the prescribed proforma duly signed by the Head of the institution and shall be submitted to AICTE not later than one month after completion.
- c. - i. The balance amount of the grant will be reimbursed to the university/institution only on submission of the above documents. Certainly. To address the requirements of faculty members, postgraduate students, research scholars, practicing engineers from the industry, and lubricant manufacturers, a dedicated "Tribology Lab" has been established within the Department of Mechanical Engineering at AISSMS College of Engineering, Pune. The lab's capabilities have been enhanced through the incorporation of specialized equipment, including the Four Ball Tester with image acquisition system and the KRL Shear Stability attachment. These additions have significantly bolstered the Tribology facilities within the realm of Mechanical Engineering.

The equipment can be used to demonstrate fundamental concepts of tribology in lectures and laboratory sessions also during faculty development programs and workshops. This promotes a deeper understanding of friction, lubrication, and wear phenomena.

The Four Ball Tester assists in the formulation and testing of new lubricant compositions. Industries can evaluate the effectiveness of different formulations and optimize lubricant properties to enhance machinery performance and durability.

Industries can benefit from reduced maintenance costs and improved efficiency by selecting the most appropriate lubricants based on Four Ball Tester results. This leads to longer equipment lifetimes and fewer downtimes.

Further, PG and PhD scholars who are pursuing their research in materials will be also get benefitted with these created facilities.

In both academic and industrial settings, the Four Ball Tester contributes significantly to advancing the understanding of tribology and optimizing the performance of materials, lubricants, and mechanical systems.
