Institute Central Library is using commercial software as well as Open Source software for Automation of Library Services. The Library is place where information becomes knowledge.

Integrated Library Management System (ILMS)

The Institute library is fully integrated through the Library Information and Management System (SLIM) software having version 21. The library uses various modules of slim software like book acquisition, Cataloguing, Journals Control, Bar code printing, Email Alerts Reminders, and Circulation Library **OPAC** web link is provided the website on https://aissmscoelibrary.weebly.com/library-opac--collection.html. to students and faculty for renewal of books and searching library materials. The RFID system is implemented in the Library which is helping students and faculty for Faster, easier checkout and check-in of library materials. RFID-enabled security gates are useful for anti-theft dictation. To access the library resources information kiosk system is installed in the Library.

The library has acquired a good collection of books and journals in the area of various engineering disciplines. The library collection includes 53058 (Print and E-Books) as well as 1016 E-journals and 91 national journals. Overall library investment is Rs 23687601.24.

Subscription of E-Resources – Library is subscribing to various E-Resources like Science Direct, IEEE, ASCE, ASME, Springer, and McGraw Hill database.
