

GUIDELINES FOR PURSUING HIGHER STUDIES.

The All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society (AISSMS) has been consistently following a policy of encouraging the teaching & non-teaching staff to improve skills and quality by way of improving their qualification. The Management of the Society appreciates that the quality of teaching and research in the educational institutions run by the Society will improve if the staff is encouraged to improve the skills and quality.

Keeping in view the Society policy, the following guidelines have been formulated to grant approval to faculty / staff (herein after mentioned as " Individual ") interested in joining various courses in engineering / science / management:-

- 1. The teaching and non-teaching staff will be encouraged to pursue ME/ M.Phil /MBA/Ph.D or equivalent studies approved by the AICTE or the Government.
- 2. The permission for pursuing such courses will be granted on the following basis:-
- 2.1 The Individual carries out normal duties (teaching / non-teaching) unhampered, after the registration for the course.

2.2 The Individual carries out the work related to the examination and other duties, time to time, as required by the Department / College / University.

2.3 The Individual will be allowed to attend the classes either by adjusting the teaching load or workload or by availing short leave with due permission of the Head of the Department and the Principal. The requirement of leave, over and above normally permitted as per the rules, will be considered on without pay basis, subject to approval.

2.4 Certain educational institutions (example IIT's) require the Individual to stay in the campus for certain period to complete the course work. The Individual proceeding on long leave for such purpose will be allowed to do so on without - pay basis, such long leave will be permitted only to one Individual per academic year from a Department.

2.5 The individual pursuing full-time course will be required to sign the Service Bond as per the terms and conditions mentioned in the following paragraphs. The Clause 4.0 is not applicable to such cases.

3. The financial support towards the studies is available under two options mentioned in Section 3.1 and 3.2.

3.1 Option - I

The Individual who has already pursued higher studies is given an option to seek re-imbursement of the tuition fees, encashment of leave — without-pay, total of both upto a maximum of Rupees one lakh, after acquiring the qualification, under the following conditions:-

- (a) The Individual signs a bond to serve AISSMS for a period of five years.
- (b) The Individual submits advance cheques of a nationalized bank, for Rs. three lakh, plus the amount reimbursed to the Individual. The cheque should be submitted along with the bond as mentioned in 3.1 (a). If the individual commits a breach of the service Bond prior to it's stipulated period, the individual is liable and undertakes to reimburse the employer forthwith entire amount of Rupees three lakh plus the amount paid to him with interest calculated @ 12% by the employer. Only on such reimbursement the employer may complete the formalities of relieving the individual from the said Service Bond. The service bond will get automatically nullified, once the Individual completes the period of Service Bond, mentioned in Clause 3.1(a). The advance cheques, if any, remaining after the expiry of Service Bond, will be returned to the Individual.
- (c) Incase of the Individual, who has acquired the higher degree, who's basic salary for the period of three years starting from the date of signing the bond is less than Rupees three lakh, then the bond value of Rs.three lakh mentioned in Clause 3.1(b), will be reduced to that amount, other conditions remain the same.
- (d) In case the individual has not taken permission at the time of registration for higher studies from the employer the above option would be available variable to such individual only if he seeks post facto permission from the employer. It would be within the discretion of the employer to grant post facto permission to him.

3.2 Option - II

The Individual pursuing higher studies is given an option to seek reimbursement of the tuition fees, salary during study leave, total of both up to maximum Rupees one lakh, starting from the date of Individual's registration for the course, under the following conditions:-

- (a) The Individual signs a bond to serve AISSMS for a period of five years, beginning from the date of acquiring the requisite qualification. The bond shall be signed at the time of registration / seeking official permission for joining the course.
- (c) The Individual submits advance cheques of a nationalized bank, for Rs.3/-lakh, The cheque should be submitted along with the bond as mentioned in Clause 3.2 (a). If the individual commits a breach of the service Bond prior to it's stipulated period, the individual is liable and undertakes to reimburse the employer forthwith entire amount of Rs.3/- lakh plus the amount paid to him with interest calculated @ 12% by the employer. Only on such reimbursement the employer may complete the formalities of relieving the individual from the said Service Bond. The service bond will get automatically nullified, once the Individual completes the period of Service Bond, mentioned in Clause 3.2(a). The advance cheques, if any,

remaining after the expiry of Service Bond, will be retuned to the Individual.

- (d) Incase the post graduate degree or the doctoral degree is not acquired within the period of three or seven years from the date of registration, respectively, only one extension for the period of one year may be considered. In case the degree is not acquired even after the expiry of extended period, the individual is liable & undertakes to reimburse the employer forthwith entire amount paid to him with interest calculated @ 12% by the employer. Only on such reimbursement the employer may complete the formalities of relieving the individual from the said Service Bond.
- 4. An individual desirous of pursuing higher studies without any financial assistance and also without any adjustment in teaching load, work load or leave would still be liable to take permission of the employer for pursuing the said higher studies. Such permission would be granted by the employer on such terms & conditions as deemed fit in the interest of the institution.
- 5. The Individual shall submit a copy of the Ph.D / Post graduate thesis or other reports, including the publications arising therefrom to the College library.
- 6. The proforma of the Service Bond is enclosed as Appendix A. The bond will be signed by the Individual and the appropriate authority from AISSMS, on a Rs. 100/- non judicial stamp paper.
- 7. All financial reimbursements will be subject to the deduction of tax at source, as per the provisions of Income Tax Rules prevailing.
- 8. Notwithstanding the terms and conditions mentioned in this Office Order, the AISSM Society reserves the right to reject any application for permission for higher studies, without assigning any reason.


