



The camp started around 11am after the greetings and inauguration of the events lined up. Two eye specialists were arranged for this camp. Firstly all the villagers willing for the check up were asked to enroll their names and provide the Aadhar Nos. outside. Then one by one they were asked to first of all sanitize their hands and only then enter the check up area. There was one volunteer appointed to look into this. After that the check up was being held in two steps - 1st being to read out the letters closing one eye alternatively and 2nd was their eyes were machine checked by the eye specialist and then given advice accordingly. Also the villagers discussed the problems that they faced related to their eyes with the doctor. Once the whole check up was done villager could also get spectacles according to the nos. they were given by the doctor. There were 3 volunteers coordinating all this. The check up went on for almost 4 and a half hours.

All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society's, College of Engineering, Pune-01, National Service Scheme has conducted a Computer Literacy session for school students at ZP School, Kalyan, Tal. Haveli, Dist. Pune The purpose of this study was to investigate students' perceptions of computer literacy skills they had obtained prior to enrolling in a university and to develop implications and recommendations for teaching a college-level computer course. Students were asked to identify their skill level in various types of software and their exposure to computer concepts and issues In our contribution we focused on finding out the information and computer literacy of high school students. Many of them were familiar with the computer and the parts. Even they knew a little about the software part of the computer. We found that the main activity of students on the internet is the search for information (e.g. themes on essays, complementary information to the curriculum...). It means that computer literacy of students is improving.
