



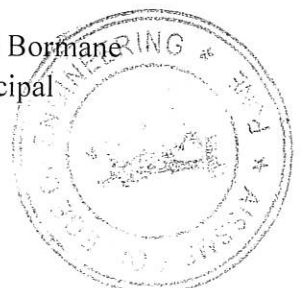

Industrial visit was carried out at GMRT on 27th January 2023, for SEM VI and SEM VIII Electronics and telecommunication Engineering Students. The main objective behind the visit was to make the students aware about how the antennas work and how do they play a major role in our lives. The Journey began at 7:00am on the morning of the 27th January 2023. All had breakfast near Manchar

and visited Mobile repeater station close to restaurant. Students were already studied significance of repeater station in courses like Digital Communication, Cellular Networks, Computer Networks, etc so this field visit has given actual experience of Repeater Station.

Time slot of 10.00 am was already given by GMRT administration and we all reached by 10.30am. The site for GMRT, about 10 km east of Narayangaon town on the Pune-Nasik highway, was selected after an extensive search in many parts of India, considering criteria such as low man-made radio noise, availability of good communication, vicinity of industrial, educational and other infrastructure and, a geographical latitude sufficiently north of the geomagnetic equator in order to have a reasonably quiet ionosphere and yet be able to observe a good part of the southern sky as well. After reaching the facility students were guided by the staff member towards one of the big antennas. It was great to know that GMRT consists of 30 fully steerable gigantic parabolic dishes of 45m diameter each spread over distances of up to 25 km.

After introduction all students were shown the big antenna and were told about how it works and were guided about its various functionalities. The metre wavelength part of the radio spectrum has been particularly chosen for study with GMRT because man-made radio interference is considerably lower in this part of the spectrum in India. Fourteen of the thirty dishes are located more or less randomly in a compact central_array in a region of about 1 sq km. The remaining sixteen dishes are spread out along the 3 arms of an approximately 'Y'-shaped_configuration over a much larger region, with the longest interferometric baseline of about 25 km.

The visit concluded with an interactive session for the students, where they got an opportunity interact with the concerned authorities and gain more knowledge. The trip included over 36 students of Electronics and Telecommunication branch, visiting the facility. It was a great learning experience for one and all.

After visiting GMRT, we had historical visit to Shivneri fort which is approximately 30Km away from Narayangaon.

Event Objective & Outcome:

Objective of this visit is to provide information of Giant Metrewave Radio Telescope (GMRT) station situated at Narayangaon, Tal-Junner, Dist-Pune to the students. GMRT is one of the most challenging experimental programmes in basic sciences undertaken by Indian scientists and engineers. Students should get aware of this station. They should know the working of this station. On 28th February GMRT celebrates science day and they organize project exhibition. So our students came across different project and get inspired to design and develop different projects. Students also observed that the RF waves are captured by steerable gigantic parabolic dishes of 45m diameter at

GMRT, these RF waves are then processed for filtering and finally scientists at GMRT try to find out new stars in the space. At GMRT the instrument has state-of-the-art electronics systems developed indigenously and consisting of the following main sub units. • Antenna feeds at six different frequency bands between 50 MHz and 1500 MHz, having good polarization characteristics as well as simultaneous multiband operation. • Low-noise amplifiers, local oscillator synthesizers, mixers, IF amplifiers. • Optical fibres linking the entire array with the CEB. These are used both for the telemetry signals and local oscillator phase reference communication between the CEB and each antenna base. • A digital 2,30,000-channel FX-type correlator providing upto 128 spectral channels and covering a maximum bandwidth of 32 MHz
