



Mr. Nitish talked on opportunities for young budding Chemical engineers. He also motivated them in COVID -19 pandemic situation.


Dr. M Y Naniwadekar, introduced the guest of session Mr. Nitish. The event was started at 9: 00 a.m.



III 1 REPORT


The AIChE student Chapter organized an INDUSTRY INSTITUTE INTERACTION Phase-I program on 5th September 2020.





Industry Institute Interaction 2 Report







The AIChE student Chapter organized an INDUSTRY INSTITUTE INTERACTION Phase-II program on 12th Sept 2020.







REPORT on "Unfolding the journey of a successful start-up", Founders of Claro Energy Mr Kartik Wahi and Gaurav Kumar

Mr Kartik Wahi and Mr Gaurav Kumar have explained the students about the challenges on their start up mission for "Claro Agro Solutions Pvt Ltd". How an idea can be converted to a business set up and how to overcome the struggles with various factors, has been very well explained by both of them. Students were excited to hear from them and the questions from students have proved that they have also started to think about a start up once they complete their 4 years of Engineering.


Gaurav has explained the students that what should be the prime objective at the initial stage of a start up, how to scale your ideas for a start up, how to take advantage of the experience from your former corporate job and what is the correct time to think about a start up.

Mr. Kartik explained the difference between the education from abroad and the education from India, and also at what extent this education helped him to develop his idea.

Both of them clearly told the students that to begin and sustain a start-up, one needs to have the right temperament, right people and sufficient capital to run it.

Overall, they have made the students to believe in themselves to become an entrepreneur and also promised to help the students with their start up ideas.

The talk ended with a promise from the speakers to interact with a more focussed group who intend to start their own venture.
