DINDI REPORT

Pandharpur Wari is an annual pilgrimage Alandi to Pandharpur in Maharashtra in the month of July every year. Sant Dnyaneshwar and Tukaram are taken from their respective shrines to Pandharpur. This is 21 days March on foot from various locations in Maharashtra to Vithoba temple, Pandharpur, attracts a total of over a million pilgrims. Devotees from Maharashtra and nearby areas set out for Pandharpur,

As per the circular of Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune-07 about the Swachha Wari, Nirmal Wari, Nisarg Wari, the All India Shri Shivaji Memorial Society's , College Of Engineering, Pune-01, National Service Scheme unit has been participated in the Niramal wari Programmme on 8th and 9th July 2018 at Kasture Chowk , Nana Peth, Pune.

The volunteers reached the Ladkat School, Nana Peth, Pune on 8th July 2018 at 6.00am early in the morning. It was tea time early in the morning, so the the volunteers immediately helped to the local people for serving tea, biscuits and breakfast to the pilgrims of Dindi. Further the volunteers have been carried out the cleaning drive in Kasture Chowk and Kondhare wada area. The volunteers collected the plastic wrappers of Biscuits, empty glasses of tea and water and empty breakfast plates. While conducting the cleanliness drive volunteers also make awareness regarding the cleanliness. The volunteers appealed to the people that do not spit on road and public places. Simultaneously the some group of volunteers helped local people and police in the traffic management and directing the people participated in Dindi. Some volunteers help the missing pilgrims to find out their dindi location. After 11.00am all the boys volunteers started working for the arrangement of the lunch for the pilgrims in association with local organizer and also washed the utensils for cooking of food. The girls volunteers



involved themselves in kitchen job and helping the cooks and the women in preparing of dough, puri, washing and cutting of vegetables. The girl's volunteers also learn from the pilgrims how to make the Jawar and Bajari bhakari (Roti). The volunteers visited to the different dindi and they had some conversation with pilgrims and enjoyed the Bhajan, Kirtan and learn the tradition. It was the lunch time; volunteers took the charge of serving the food to the pilgrims with the glass of water. Within the period of 2hrs, volunteers served the food more than 1000 pilgrims. Then the volunteers took lunch. During the lunch break, Mrs. Manisha Kondhare, Corporator, PMC, visited the place and felicitated our NSS unit and appreciated their work and help. After everyone's lunch, volunteers removed the chairs and table and cleaned the area. In the evening volunteers again helped in serving the tea and biscuits and did some cleaning and traffic management up to 8.00 pm also dialogue with the pilgrims to know about their village and life.

At 8.00pm the volunteers of night shift arrived at the location. They also helped locals in serving food and other managements. They had good talks with all varkari's and enjoyed Bhajan and Kirtan with them. Volunteers also helped those people in making arrangements of their sleeping. On 9th July 2018, the both the Palkhi's have been proceed for the next destination. After the palkhi left the nana peth, the every Main and internal roads was full of garbage. Volunteers took the initiative along with the sanitation department, PMC and cleaned each and every area of Nana Peth. 










DAY 4::FRIDAY::11/01/2019


