





- The women in the age group of 50-70 are mostly illiterate. Few of them are familiar with the basics of the language (Marathi) like the alphabet & numbers.
- The women in the age group of 30-50 were mostly educated up to primary school or secondary school. There were a very few of them educated up to higher secondary school.
- The age group below 20-30 included women's almost educated many of them were educated up till higher secondary & so on, in which few of them do some job.
- The rest were school-going girls.

The women who are illiterate or have just basic education were asked if they would like to learn now.














coordinating all this. The check up went on for almost 4 and a half hours. 107 villagers check their eyes.
















VALUE EDUCATION WORKSHOP REPORT




