The total expenses on tuition, computer use, room rent, teaching material, caution money and other fee for two years would be approximately Rs. 11,85,000/-. This fee does not cover personal expenses on food, travel, clothing, laundry, etc. The fee component is payable in six installments during the entire two year programme. In addition to course fee, student have to pay Rs. 1,00, 000/- in each term (up to 4th term) for the International Immersion Programme (Voluntary participation). If the International Immersion programme is not conducted, the cost of fee charged for the immersion programme activity shall be adjusted against the term fee.

In the case of cost of IIP exceeds the fee collected for the purpose, the difference shall then be borne by the participating students. Similarly, in case of savings the same shall be adjusted against the term fee.




